Re: Proposed Change in Degree Requirements for the Master of Engineering Program

We are in the process of submitting a proposal for revitalizing and converting a school-wide Master of Engineering (MEng) degree from a state-supporting to a self-supporting degree program (SSGPDP) in the Henry Samueli School of Engineering and Applied Science (HSSEAS). HSSEAS FEC has unanimously approved the degree proposal during the December 2018 meeting.

The school-wide MEng degree already exists in UCLA Senate Regulation 608 (see <https://senate.ucla.edu/regulations/chapter31>). However, the current state-supported Master of Engineering degree is granted to graduates of the Engineering Executive Program, a two-year work-study program consisting of graduate-level professional courses in the management of technology enterprises. The degree requirements need to be revised to reflect the requirements of the proposed MEng program. The revision of Senate Regulation needs to be approved by FEC. Your support for the proposed change in degree requirements will be greatly appreciated.
